## The National FFA Convention

I traveled to Indianapolis, Indiana for an outreach with the Fellowship of Christian Farmers to the kids who were part of the National FFA Convention. We saw hundreds of salvations and divine appointments with our future leaders from all over the USA and Puerto Rico.

At one point I was getting ready to pray the sinner's prayer with a group of kids (a couple were from Puerto Rico) and the fire alarm went off. (It's hard to imagine that out of 55,000 kids that one of them would be ornery enough to set the fire alarm off-Ha!) An announcement rang out over the loud speaker telling everyone to leave the building but I remembered the story of DL Moody. One Sunday night he preached on salvation and told the people to think on the message and that the next Sunday he would give them an opportunity to receive Jesus. As the crowd was dismissing the Great Chicago Fire was beginning to ravage the city. DL Moody never saw those people again and many of them died in the fire. He said not leading them to Jesus that night was the greatest regret of his life. I wasn't going to make the same mistake so before I let those kids go I quickly prayed the sinner's prayer with them.

After sharing the Gospel message with them, a group of girls from Oklahoma prayed with me to receive salvation. One of them was so touched that she came back a little while later with her cousin so that she could hear the good news of the Gospel. Her cousin and some others that were there ended up getting saved as well, all glory to God.

## Albia, Iowa

The last Sunday of October I preached at River-Life Family Worship Center pastored by Brad and Denise Gray. The morning service I preached on the importance of evangelism and then for the evening service I preached on how to evangelize. I went to Bible School with Brad and Denise in the early eighties so it was good to see them and fellowship with them. The people of their church liked the messages and were encouraged to evangelize.
