Up-Coming Outreach

The Four State Farm Show in Pittsburg, Kansas will be July 17th-19th. Even though it takes place outdoors in the middle of the summer in Kansas and will be very hot, it is on my heart to go and I believe that the preaching of the Gospel will be hot also. Please be praying that the finances for this trip will be supplied.

On-Going Ministry

As well as needing the finances for our outreaches we also need to cover the expenses of our on-going ministry of our Bible correspondence course and programs on the radio.

"Finding Hope" is our weekly radio program that airs on World Harvest Radio's shortwave signals reaching into every part of the world. The signals are able to go into areas that are difficult or politically impossible to in person.

On regular radio we are heard every week in 5 different cities of the United States (St. Louis; Mobile, Alabama; Omaha, Nebraska; Albuquerque, New Mexico; and Tupelo, Mississippi). We have a 15 minute program called "Reaping the Harvest". I teach on evangelism and the things that will help people become better Christians trying to stir them up to witness and to train them to witness.

Stepping Stones, our Bible correspondence course, is also an on-going ministry and expense. We disciple people from all over the world through Stepping Stones and the only text needed to take the course is the Bible. If someone needs a Bible we mail one to them along with the first lesson. So far this year we have mailed out 61 first lessons, 23 Bibles and have had 1 person complete all 12 lessons, others continue to move through the course at their own pace.
