## 2009 Northern Navajo Nation Fair In Shiprock, New Mexico

At the beginning of October I took 5 Ministry Academy students on our annual outreach to the Navajo Nation. They worked hard and did a great job of ministering.



On our way to New Mexico we stopped at Faith Community Church in Great Bend, Kansas. Each person in our group testified at the Wednesday night youth group meeting.

We were blessed to spend the night at Faith Community and drove to Farmington, New Mexico the next day.

We arrived late at Navajo Ministries where we stayed during our time in New Mexico and were invited to share our testimonies at their Friday morning devotional meeting the next morning. After that we then were



asked to be guests on KNMI's morning show (KNMI is the radio station owned and operated by Navajo Ministries and reaches into a good part of the four corners region.) In war the air force goes out first and bombs the enemy to soften the resistance and then the ground troops are sent in. Even

though we are not in a physical war and we are in a spiritual war and so when we were on the radio ministering it was like sending out the air force first with the Word of God and then we went in with the ground troops in ministry at the Shiprock Fair.



We spent the rest of the day on Friday in ministry from our booth at the fair witnessing, preaching, praying, passing out Gospel tracts, Jesus stickers, salvation bracelets, Bibles and other Gospel literature. We also passed out 8 boxes of Joyce Meyer magazines which are full of good Bible teaching. They were donated by Joyce Meyer Ministries and were a blessing to the Navajo Nation. We worked with Pastor Tso's church, Victory Life Church, in Shiprock and put their address on the back of the tracts we passed out. Friday night we went out into the carnival area to minister to the Navajo adults, kids and teenagers.





Saturday is the day of the big parade. Around 125,000 line the parade route and they arrive early to secure a good vantage point. Before the parade began we passed out thousands of tracts which gave the waiting spectators something to do as they passed the time before the parade started and witnessed as we were able to.

We were able to pray with so many people to receive Jesus into their lives during this outreach but probably the most dramatic conversion was when a 16 year old satan worshipper prayed to get saved. He told us he was the one responsible for the pentagrams painted as graffiti around there and that he cut himself and had been suicidal. After much talking with him about the Gospel he prayed to receive Jesus. We then laid hands on him, anointed him with oil and prayed for him. The power of God hit him so strong that



he fell under it and began to shake. This all took place with people walking all about us. When he stood up he was not as pale looking as before, he was a brand new man in Christ Jesus.

On our way back we stopped again at Faith Community Church in Great Bend and testified at the youth group led by Marty Steinert. We want to thank Marty for letting us minister there and for the fellowship with him and the youth. We also want to thank Pastor Sandy Kennedy and Faith Community for their hospitality in letting us stay there. If we hadn't have stayed there coming and going it would have made for a very long 20 hour trip. A big thank you also goes to Jim Baker and Navajo Ministries for their hospitality and letting us minister there.
