St. Louis Dream Center Open Air Meeting

The weekend of May 26th The St. Louis Dream Center had their first open air outreach of the summer. On Friday night we set up our booth and gave away salvation bracelets, Jesus stickers and "I Went to Hell" booklets by Kenneth Hagin. As we explained the plan of salvation using the salvation bracelets 8 people prayed to receive Jesus as Lord and Savior.

I took a stack of the "I Went to Hell" booklets to pass out to the people who didn't come to our booth. The booklet describes the experience of Kenneth Hagin when he was a teen. He was a church goer and had been baptized, but had never received Jesus as Lord and Savior. He was on his death bed and 3 different times his spirit left his body and descended toward the gates of hell. The third time that it happened he cried out to Jesus to be saved. Later in the booklet, his spirit left his body but that time he got a taste of the glory of heaven. Your financial gifts enabled us to buy these booklets.

I passed out these booklets and because of the title and content they were very popular. It would be hard to read that booklet and not get saved.

I took the booklets to the playground, basketball court, throughout the park and neighborhood. The people were very receptive to the witnessing. About 23 people responded by praying the sinner's prayer with me. 2 of them were adult men and the rest were teenagers or children.

Later on Pastor Robert, the Dream Center high school youth pastor, and I went down the street passing out booklets and witnessing to people on the street and in front of their houses. As a result, there were 8 teenagers who received the Lord.

Totally, about 38 people responded to the gospel message through the bracelets and witnessing. All of them seemed like good, genuine conversions and good divine appointments. Instant follow-up was done, telling the people how to live the Christian life, inviting them to the Dream Center and open air meetings and Pastor Robert got the phone numbers of some of the teenagers to be able to pick them up for church.

Shortwave Radio

Because of your faithful support, we will be reaching more of the world with the Good News of Jesus Christ. Starting Saturday, June 3rd Finding Hope will air via World Harvest Radio's Angel 5 into Africa and the Middle East. This means our program is now broadcast on 3 of their 5 stations. Angel 2 reaches into Europe and North America and Angel 3 reaches into Asia.

Shortwave radio is a wonderful tool to reach the peoples of the world. Literally millions of people throughout the world listen to shortwave radio. In some areas of the world, like Africa, shortwave is the primary method of radio broadcasting. In other countries, its audience is growing rapidly. In fact, the number of shortwave listeners in the United States has doubled in the last decade. This audience is expected to double again in the next ten years.

Bible Correspondence Course

We have begun a Bible Correspondence Course called Stepping Stones. It is a twelve lesson course that covers such topics as; salvation, the daily Christian walk, dealing with sin and temptation, choosing a church, etc. and is designed to help new Christians begin their walk with God. We offer this course as a way of follow-up to people who accept Jesus as their Savior through our ministry and to others who desire to go over the basics of Christianity. We are making it available free of charge, the only expense being the postage to send the lessons through the mail. Cinco de Mayo 2006



On Saturday, May 6th Charles Hodge and I went to Kansas City to minister for Cinco de Mayo. We went there because Kansas City has a large Hispanic population and I have ministered at Cinco de Mayo celebrations there in the past and knew that they are a great opportunity to share the gospel.

Block Party

To start the day we teamed up with Jerry Holloway of Fishers of Men Ministries and helped with his block party at Bethany Park in Kansas City, Kansas which is located in a very Hispanic area. Also involved in the block party were 2 Hispanic churches from Kansas City, Kansas, "La Fe en Jesucristo" and "Restauración La Vida", and Xtreme team, a Youth with a Mission outreach based out of Lee's Summit, Missouri.



While at the block party, which was an Hispanic outreach, I encountered some opportunities to witness to people I hadn't expected finding there. I met 3 men from Africa. One from Somalia, one from

the Sudan and one from East Africa. One of them was a Muslim high school student who attends Wyandotte High School in Kansas City. After spending some time talking individually with them, they all prayed the sinner's prayer with me.



The block party consisted of bounce houses, free prizes, hot dogs and chips, preaching, music, dancers, power team feats by Xtreme team, and witnessing using salvation bracelets. Charles and I brought with us tracts made by my wife Julie that had the plan of salvation on one side in English and in Spanish on the other side. The St. Louis Dream Center printed out the tracts on brightly colored paper that I supplied. Everyone involved with the outreach used the tracts and many were passed out. I preached a 15 minute sermon with a Spanish translator. Charles and I did a lot of one on one witnessing and saw many pray with us to receive Jesus as Lord and Savior.

After the block party, Charles and I went to the Missouri side of Kansas City to a Cinco de Mayo festival which included a carnival and blocked off streets with booths. There we witnessed one on one and passed out the English/Spanish tracts that were also used at the block party.
