Evangelism Nuggets

As we get closer to the return of Christ I've noticed that God is giving people more visits or visions of heaven and hell and visitations of God's glory. Some of those people are writing books about their experiences.

At the Wal-Mart we shop at there is a book called "90 Minutes in Heaven" a true story of Don Piper who died in a bad car wreck. For 90 minutes he visited heaven, seeing friends and family who went to heaven before him. A Christian came to the scene of the accident and God told him to pray for Don even though he was already dead and God raised him from the dead.

"23 Minutes in Hell" is a book by Bill Wiess. God supernaturally gave Bill a visitation to hell so that he could come back and warn people about that horrible place.

Mary Kay Baxter has written "The Divine Revelation of Hell" in which she tells the story of

Jesus taking her down to hell to see what it is like so that she can warn people not to go there.

A little book by Kenneth Hagin titled "I Went to Hell" is a book that I like to use for soul winning. There are other books with similar stories to what these people wrote about including an account in the Bible about the Apostle Paul visiting heaven in 2 Corinthians 12:1-4.

Do you think that God gave these people these experiences so that they could sell a lot of books? I don't. I believe the reason is because God loves us so much that He is going the extra mile and doing everything He can to warn us about hell and to let us know about the great glories of heaven so that we will get saved before it is too late. I believe another reason is so that people would be stirred up to evangelize with great urgency. I encourage you to get these books to stir up yourself to live right, stay on the straight and narrow path, and to pray for the lost and witness to them like never before.
