
## Great News!!

In February we celebrated one year of ministry of being on the shortwave signals of World Harvest Radio. We began with being on one station, Angel 3, with the eventual goal of being on all five Angel stations. In April of 2006 Angel 2 was added and in June we began airing on Angel 5.

Our goal to be on all of World Harvest Radio's shortwave stations was reached on March 17, 2007 as Finding Hope began to air on Angel 1, and on Angel 4. ***With many thanks to you, our faithful supporters, we are now reaching the whole world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.***

As it get warmer there are a lot more people on the streets to witness to. I have been going out with the St. Louis Dream Center and my daughter, Kara, has been joining us. We drive around in DC vans and give out sandwiches, drinks and candy that the church has provided. We also give out tracts that we created and the church printed out.

## St. Patrick's Day Parade



The St. Patrick's Day parade in St. Louis is noted as one of the best in the country with over 200,000 spectators and before the parade starts there is a five mile run that has over 6000 participants. A gathering of people like that is a perfect opportunity for evangelism.

It's a little like Mardi Gras except that there are green beads and green beer. People were pretty receptive. We created a St. Patrick's Day tract and the Dream Center provided the copies of it that we passed out. My family and I along with a woman from the Dream Center passed out over 1200 tracts. The Dream Center also donated a lot of worship music tapes to pass out.



## Stepping Stones

We have had over 50 people from all over the nation and the world sign up for our Bible Correspondence Course.
